FREE Medicine Collection Program

Safely dispose of your unwanted, expired or unused medicines for FREE at one of Ramsey County's two public drop boxes. This year-round collection program helps prevent crime and protects the environment. Storing unwanted, expired and unused medicines can lead to drug abuse or poisoning, and medicines flushed down the drain or disposed of in the trash can harm the environment.

Medicines Accepted:

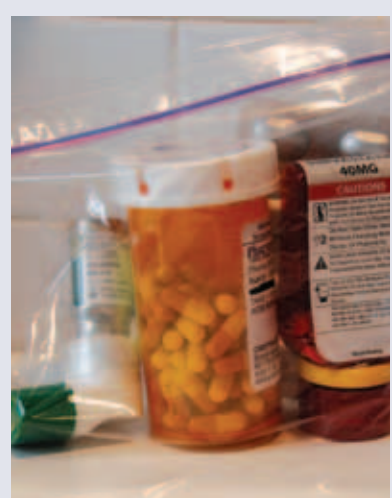
Medicine from households are accepted in any form, including prescription, over-the-counter and pet medicines. Examples:

- Blister packs
- Capsules and pills
- Creams and gels
- Inhalers
- IV bags
- Liquids
- Patches
- Powders
- Sprays
- Vials

Materials Not Accepted:

No needles or sharps. (Accepted FREE at Ramsey County's household hazardous waste collection site: 5 Empire Dr, Saint Paul.)

No medicines accepted from businesses, health care facilities, long-term-care facilities, pharmacies, doctors' offices or veterinary clinics.



Guidelines:

- Keep medicines in their original container and place them in a clear plastic bag (pills can remain in their blister packs).
- Use a marker to cross out your name on medicine containers.
- Place medicine that is no longer in its original container in a clear plastic bag and write the name of the medicine on the bag.
