

Crosby Farm Park

LOCATION: Crosby Farm Park is located between Shepard Road and the Mississippi River. It stretches from the Hwy 5 bridge to past the I 35 E bridge. The parking lot can be reached by taking Crosby Farm Road off of Shepard Rd. There are a series of paved and dirt trails through the park. MAP #: 23

HABITAT: The majority of the park is flood plain forest with a mixed oak woods along the bluffs. There are wetlands around Crosby Lake. There is a line of limestone and sandstone outcrops on the north side of the park. It also has sandy shoreline of the Mississippi River.

REGULAR BIRDS: Herons, waterfowl, raptors, Barred Owl, Pileated Woodpecker, and Brown Creepers are residents. Thrushes and warblers in migration. Blue-gray Gnatcatchers, American Redstarts, Yellow Warblers and Prothonotary Warblers nest in the park.
