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Project Update

Construction progress continues on Century Avenue. There has recently been a flurry of activity on Century Avenue and Valley Creek Road recently. This update focuses on retaining wall construction, site establishment, concrete installation and completion of the project in the corridor. Century Avenue and Valley Creek Road construction work is anticipated to continue through the end of June of 2010.

After completing the installation of retaining walls, the contractor poured the caps of the walls last week. The contractor also completed the painting of the walls on the south end of the project and is continuing to the north. Railing installation on the walls shall commence within the next week.

Danner's subcontractor is on site installing permanent erosion control (sodding and seeding) on the site and this will continue until completed on the project. All of the sodding/restoration and other items do need to be completed prior to the installation of the final bituminous wear course.

The concrete crew continues to finish medians, concrete curb and gutter, flat work, sidewalk, etc. this week.

The electricians completed the signal systems in the corridor. The signal systems will not be operational until the final bituminous pavement is installed on the entire project.

Valley Creek Road and Lower Afton Road is scheduled to have final pavement installed the week of June 7th with permanent lane markings. Century Avenue is scheduled to have final pavement wear installed the week of June 14th with permanent lane markings.

Please drive with caution when traveling through the project limits. The speed limit throughout the project is **35 mph** and is regularly enforced by local police.
