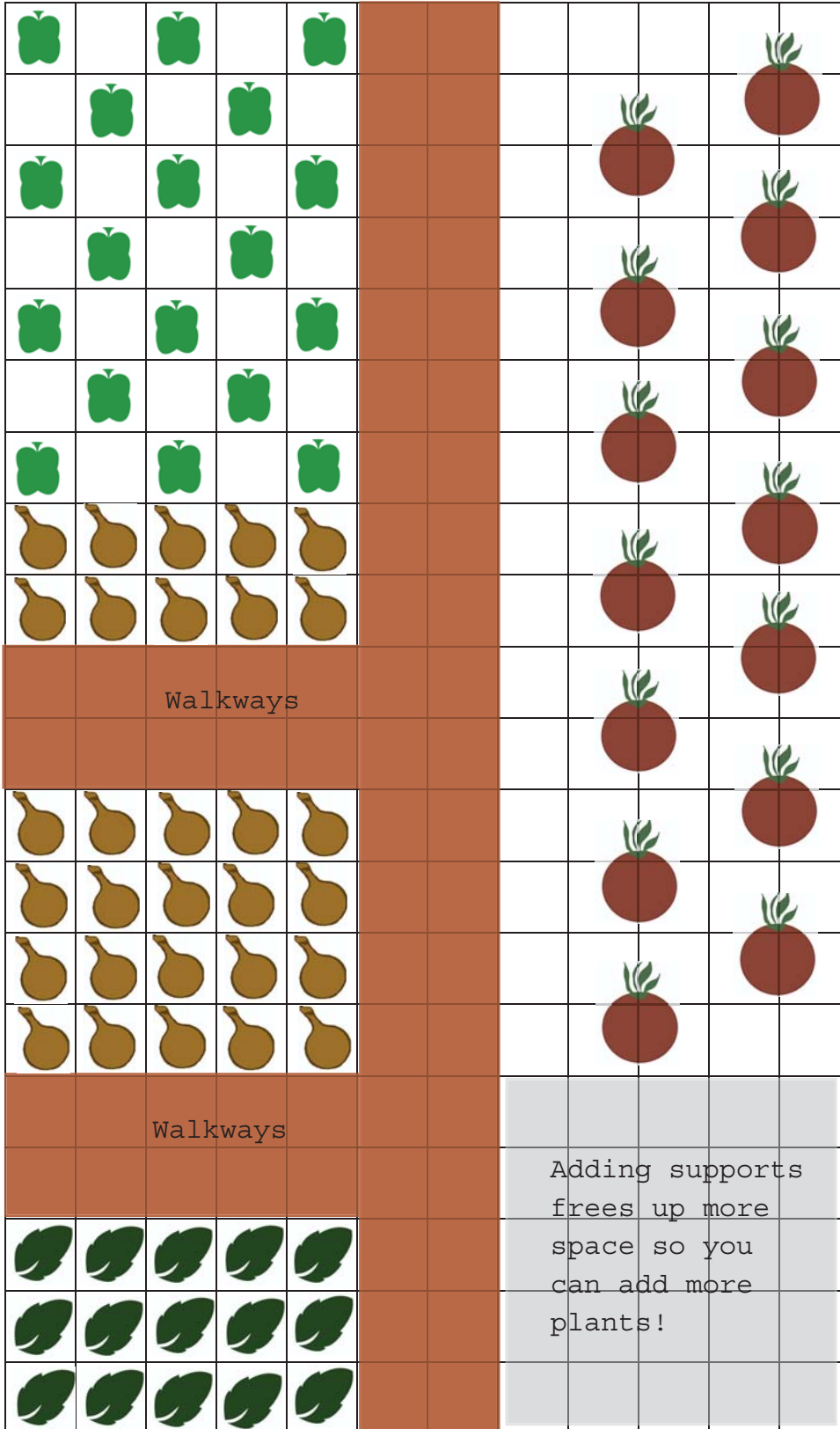


Salsa Garden with Support Structures

Each square equals 1-square foot

Sample Bed is 12 feet by 20 feet



Tomatoes come in determinate (they stop growing) and indeterminate (they grow all season long) types.

Determinates take up less room and include patio varieties. Basically, a tomatoes will require about 9 square feet per plant unless trellised. For trellised plants, plant every 4 feet.



Peppers need about 1 square feet per plant. Can plant started plants or start seeds indoors.



Onions and garlic can be planted 12 per square foot. Can plant started plants or start seed indoors.



Herbs-depending on type and variety, most herbs can be planted one plant per foot. Can plant started plants or start seed indoors.

Commonly started directly outdoors as seeds:

- Beans
- Carrots
- Corn
- Cucumbers
- Lettuce
- Peas
- Squash
- Watermelon

Commonly planted as plants/bulbs or start seeds indoors:

- Herbs
- Garlic
- Onions
- Tomatoes
- Peppers
