1. c) The average family size in Saint Paul is 3.3 persons.
2. b) 29% of the housing in Saint Paul not considered affordable.
3. d) 71% of households in the city have no children – a high percentage!
4. c) 84% of city residents over 25 years of age hold a high school diploma or higher.
5. c) The East Side has the largest number of Latino students - a surprise to many who believe it is the West Side
6. b) Hispanic – the highest percentage increase
7. a) Asian – the highest numeric increase
8. b) 22% of the adults in the city speak a language other than English at home.
9. c) 41% of public school students [17,000] speak a language other than English at home.
10. a) 16% of the adults live below the poverty line in Saint Paul.
11. b) 24% of children ages 5 to 17 lives below the poverty line in Saint Paul.
12. c) 18% of persons in the city are living with a disability.
13. c) 54% of had moved at least once within the city in the last 5 years.
14. a) Asian families in Saint Paul (primarily Hmong) have the highest ratio of this.
