A 13-week Saturday skating program for boys and girls grades K-2 on the following dates: Nov. 5, 12, 19, December 3, 10, and 17, January 7, 14, 21, and 28, February 4, 11, and 18.

The Ramsey County Parks and Recreation Department is once again offering the Mighty Kids Skating/Hockey Skills Development Program to inner-city youth (boys and girls grades K-2) living in Saint Paul who would like to learn how to skate and be introduced to the sport of hockey. The Skills Development Program is held on Saturdays for 13 weeks, for one hour each week at an arena conveniently located in your area (see below a list of arenas, times and dates). Participants do not need to know how to skate. This program will teach the fundamentals of the sport of skating. The program is limited to 60 participants per site. Participants must be in kindergarten, first or second grade during the 2005-2006 school year. **Equipment is provided which includes skates, sticks, elbow and shin pads, hockey helmets and facemask. Individuals need to provide warm clothing, such as hats and mittens to wear at each session.**
